Speed Bowls

A brief explanation

- All teams have 4 players.
- All teams are divided, with two players bowling from one end and the other two bowling from the other end. That is two pairs of opposing players at each end.
- All teams need only one set of four bowls.
- Teams toss a coin to start, the winner goes first.
- When delivered, the Jack is placed on the marked spot.
- The mat is placed on the centre line, at the marked position.
- The lead of the first pair delivers 2 bowls alternately against the opposing Lead, then the second player delivers 2 bowls alternately against the opposing 2nd player.
- The players at the other end watch and when all 8 bowls have been played, the score is entered.
- Then it is the second two players turn against their opposing two, with the original two pairs watching and scoring that end.
- There is more bowling and less walking.

Other rules:

- If the Jack goes out, ie is knocked out of your Rink (the line between the two white pegs), then the Jack should be replaced on the marked spot.
- If a player's bowl finishes outside of your Rink (the line between the two white pegs), it is out and should be removed from the green.
- If a Jack is knocked into the ditch, it is still alive if it is between the two white pegs.
- A bowl that touches the Jack when being played is a 'toucher' & if it goes in the ditch it is still alive, however, any other bowl in the ditch is out. A toucher bowl should be chalk marked for recognition.
- At the end of the game, when the bell goes, complete that end and fill out the scorecard. Get the details off the scoreboard.
- Mark your card Win or Loss, plus enter the Number of Ends won & enter Points for and against on the card.
